



Membership Restrictions

Distance Membership - A discounted rate for those who do not have a place of residence within 50 miles of the Club House. Often called Country membership. No restrictions apply to time or day of play. No voting rights. Distance members can play in competitions (not knockouts) but cannot be awarded silverware. Distance members can play in Club matches. A club bar card is available: food discounted by 10% and drinks 15%. No Lilleshall partnership. Affiliation fees applicable. Members can sign in guests at a reduced rate.

Affiliated (2nd Club) Membership - Members who wish to have Bridgnorth as their 2nd club must have full membership and handicap at another fully affiliated club, 1st Club has to be within 50 miles. Handicap is held by their Home club, Bridgnorth is their Away club. No restrictions apply to time or day of play. No voting rights. Affiliated members can play in competitions (not knockouts) but cannot be awarded silverware. Affiliated members can play in Club matches. A club bar card is available: food discounted by 10% and drinks 15%. No Lilleshall partnership. Affiliation fees applicable but need not be paid if already paid for same period at home club. Members can sign in guests at a reduced rate.

LifeStyle – Points based membership made up of three elements: membership, affiliation fees and points. Includes voting rights. Points are used each time 9 or 8 holes are played, according to a day/time grid of peak and off-peak play. LifeStyle members can play in competitions (not knockouts) but cannot be awarded silverware. Members can play in Club matches, home and away but must use points when playing at home. A club bar card is available: food discounted by 10% and drinks 15%. No Lilleshall partnership. Affiliation fees applicable. Members can sign in guests at a reduced rate.

CASC (Community Amateur Sports Club) - A reduced rate to encourage individuals with disabilities and/or those on low income to participate in golf. To qualify, applicants should be in receipt of either Disability Living Allowance or Employee Support Allowance; in both cases proof of income will be required where the applicant must demonstrate their inability to pay the full fees. If necessary equipment can be provided. Restrictions apply for weekend play: applicant must specify Saturday or Sunday play. CASC members can play in competitions and can be awarded silverware. CASC members can play in Club matches. A club bar card is available: food discounted by 10% and drinks 20%. Lilleshall partnership included. Affiliation fees applicable. Members can sign in guests at a reduced rate.
